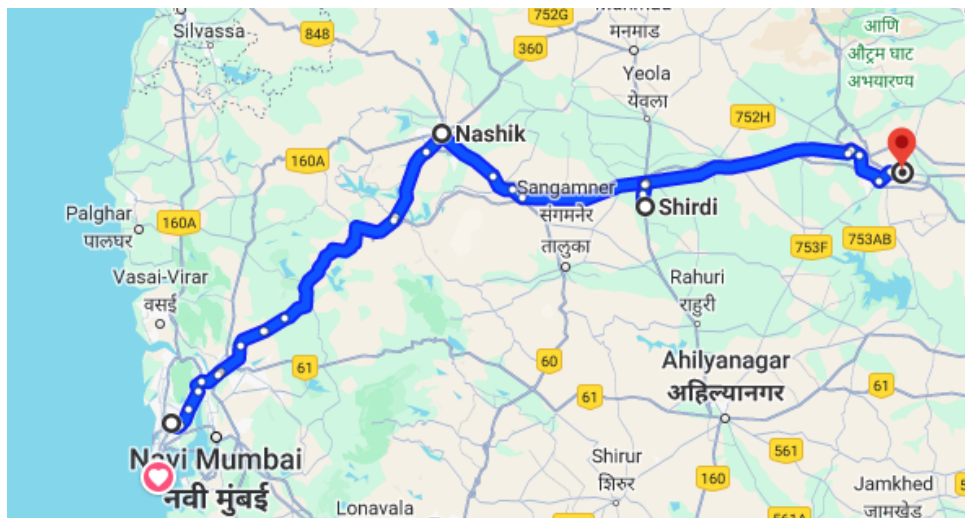




9 DAY - Temple Tour Mumbai Nashik Shirdi Aurangabad

DAY 1 : ARRIVAL MUMBAI BY FLIGHT

On arrival at Mumbai International Airport by Flight, after completing formalities, custom and immigration, come out at the exit gate, meet & greet to our assistance, transfer to Hotel (Check in time at hotel is 1400 hrs.) Rest of the day free at leisure. Overnight stay at Hotel.

Day 2 : MUMBAI – SIGHTSEEING

After breakfast, Half day city tour of Mumbai

THE GATEWAY OF INDIA: Is The Main Attraction of Mumbai City. It Was Built To Commemorate the Visit of King George V and Queen Mary for the Delhi Durbar In 1911.

HANGING GARDEN: The Hanging Gardens, Mumbai, in Mumbai, India, also known as Ferozeshah Mehta Gardens, are terraced gardens perched at the top of Malabar Hill, on its western side, just opposite the Kamala Nehru Park. They provide sunset views over the Arabian Sea and feature numerous hedges carved into the shapes of animals. The park was laid out in 1881 over Bombay's main reservoir, some say to cover the water from the potentially contaminating activity of the nearby Towers of Silence

DHOBI GHAT: A place in India, where local washer men wash clothes [open air Laundromat] is called Dhobi Ghat. Dhobi Ghat is a well-known place in Mumbai. The washers locally known as Dhobis work in open to wash the clothes from Mumbai's hotels and hospitals. There are row upon row of open-air concrete wash pens, each fitted with its own flogging stone. Termed as the world's largest outdoor laundry Dhobi Ghat is a very popular attraction among foreign tourists.

MARINE DRIVE: A Stroll Down The Marine Drive Is The Best Way To Discover Mumbai. This Winding Stretch Of Road With Tall Buildings On One Side And Sea On The Other Extends From Nariman Point To Malabar Hills. Due To Its Curved Shape And Many Street Lights, It Was Once Called The Queen's Necklace. Later Half day for shopping. Later return to hotel. Overnight stay at hotel.



DAY 3 : MUMBAI - NASHIK (170 Kms/4 Hrs)

After breakfast check out from hotel and drive to Nashik - Situated on the bank of the Godavari River, Nashik lies in Maharashtra state of India. Lined with many temples and vivid bathing ghats, the city is one of four sites of the largest religious gatherings in the world, the Kumbh Mela that takes place after every three years with each city hosting it once every 12 years. On arrival check in at hotel. Later visit **Panchavati, the sacred Ram Kund** and the serene **Kalaram Sansthan Mandir**. Delve into the legends at **Sundarnarayan Temple** and **explore the tranquil Tapovan**. **The vibrant hues of ISKCON and the intricate scenes at Muktidham**. Overnight at hotel.



DAY 4 : NASHIK – SHIRDI (100 Kms/2 Hrs Drive)

After breakfast check out from hotel and drive to Shirdi. On arrival check in at hotel. Later visit **Sri Shirdi Sai Baba Temple** - situated in the centre of Shirdi town. It is one of the most famous shrines of pilgrimage in India. The Shirdi Temple is dedicated to Sri Sai Baba and he is revered as one of the greatest saints ever seen in India, endowed with unprecedented powers, and is worshipped as an incarnation of God. Baba first made his appearance in Shirdi as a youth and remained there until he died in 1918. The temple complex of Sri Shirdi Sai Baba is spread in approximately 200 square meters. Samadhi Mandir is the main temple in the complex and is the mausoleum where Baba's mortal remains lay preserved. Apart from the Samadhi Mandir, Shirdi Sai Baba Temple premises houses a Gurusthan which is the spot where a neem tree is worshipped. According to the legend, Sri Sai Baba's remains were entombed under this neem tree. Dwarkamai is another sacred spot that is enshrined on the premises. Overnight at hotel.

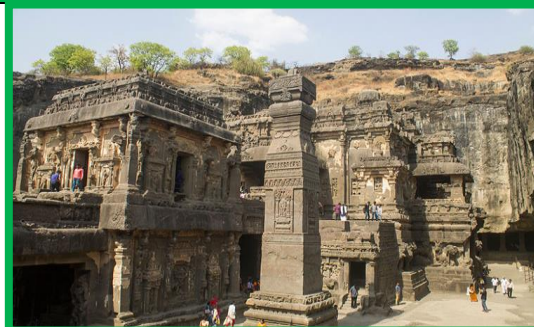
DAY 5 : SHIRDI – SHANI SHINGNAPUR – AURANGABAD (160 Kms/4 Hrs)

After breakfast check out from hotel and drive to **Shani Shingnapur** - a village in Nevasa taluka of Ahmednagar district in Maharashtra. The village is known for its popular temple of Shani Mahadev, the Hindu god associated with the planet (Graha) Saturn. The idol of Lord Shani dev at the Shingnapur temple is swayambhu and the temple is believed to be a jagrut devasthan, meaning that a deity still resides in the temple. The idol is personified in the form of a black stone. After visit continue drive to Aurangabad, on arrival check in at hotel. Rest of the day at leisure. Overnight at hotel.



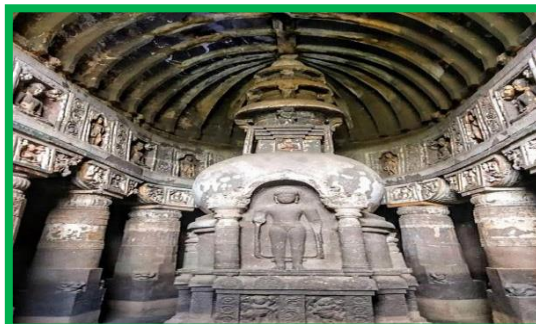
DAY 6 : AURANGABAD – ELLORA – AURANGABAD(30 Kms one way)

After breakfast proceed to visit **Ellora cave (Closed on Tuesday)** - ancient historical caves locally known as 'Verul Leni', these caves are were designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1983. Ellora is one of the top places to visit near Aurangabad. The caves at Ellora were carved out of the vertical face of the Charanandri hills between the 6th and 10th centuries AD. The carving work began around 550 AD, about the same time the Ajanta Caves were abandoned. Kailash Temple (Cave16), which is the most remarkable structure. Later visit **Bibi Ka Makbara, Panchakki and Daulatabad Fort** at Aurangabad. Overnight at hotel.



DAY 7 : AURANGABAD – AJANTA – AURANGABAD (105 Kms one way)

After breakfast proceed for day excursion of **Ajanta Caves (Closed on Monday)** – ancient Buddhist caves situated near Ajanta village in Aurangabad district of Maharashtra. Ajanta Caves are one of the oldest UNESCO World heritage sites in India and also one of the top attractions. The caves are now protected by the Archaeological Survey of India. The Caves were carved between the 2nd Century BC and 6th Century AD. Construction of the caves was carried out in two phases; the first group of caves was built around the 2nd century BC, while the second group was built between the 4th & 6th centuries. After visit return to Aurangabad. Overnight at hotel.



DAY 8 : AURANGABAD/MUMBAI (350 Kms/8-9 Hrs)

After breakfast, Check out from the Hotel and drive to Mumbai, on arrival transfer Hotel. Rest of the day at leisure. Overnight at hotel.

DAY 9 : MUMBAI (DEPARTURE) – TRANSFER TO AIRPORT

After breakfast check out from hotel and transfer to Mumbai airport to board the flight for onward destination.
