DAY 01: ARRIVE BANGALORE

On arrival at **Bangalore** Airport by Flight. After clearing customs and immigration, come out of the exit gate and meet our assistance and transfer to hotel. Check into the Hotel. (**Check in time at hotel is 1400 Hrs**). Rest for the day. **Overnight stay at Bangalore Hotel.**


DAY 02: BANGALORE TO MYSORE BY SURFACE (140 KMS. 02 HRS. APPROX.)

After breakfast at the hotel, check out from the hotel, you will drive to Mysore. Upon arrival check-in at the hotel and later proceed for the sightseeing of Mysore visiting Mysore Palace, Mysore Zoo, St Philomena Cathedral church, Chamundeshwari temple and in evening visit Brindavan garden with sound and light show. Later in evening return back to hotel and **Overnight stay at the Mysore hotel.**


DAY 03: MYSORE TO COIMBATORE BY SURFACE (200 KMS. 04 HRS. APPROX.)

Morning after breakfast, Check out from hotel & drive to Coimbatore. On arrival, check into hotel. After fresh up visit Isha foundation. Later return back to hotel. **Overnight stay at Coimbatore Hotel**

DAY 04: COIMBATORE SIGHTSEEING

After breakfast proceed for day excursion of **Isha foundation** (Address - Vellaingiri Foothills, Ishana Vihar Post, Coimbatore - 641 114, India) - the headquarters for Isha Foundation. Isha is a sacred space for self-transformation, where you can come dedicate time towards your inner growth. The center offers all four major paths of yoga kriya (energy), gnana (knowledge), karma (action), and bhakti (devotion), drawing people from all over the world. **Overnight stay at Coimbatore hotel.**

DAY 05: COIMBATORE TO COCHIN BY SURFACE (190 KMS. APPROX. 04 HRS. DRIVE)

After breakfast, check out from the Hotel, Drive to Cochin. On arrival, check into hotel. Rest day free. **Overnight stay at Cochin Hotel.**

DAY 06: COCHIN SIGHTSEEING

Morning after breakfast, sightseeing of cochin visiting – what is locally called the Jew Town, 'The Dutch Palace, Spice market at the narrow streets, The, 'The Santa Cruz Basilica' originally built in 1557 by the Portuguese and the cochin boast "Chinese fishing nets. Where you can buy fresh fish and they will make it for you at same time and you can enjoy it. Later return to hotel.

Overnight stay at Cochin Hotel.

DAY 07: COCHIN TO MUNNAR BY SURFACE (APPROX. 04 HRS. DRIVE)

After breakfast, check out from the Hotel, Drive to Munnar. On the way visit Rock caves which are dwelling caves of ancient tribals Water fall. On arrival, check into hotel.

Overnight stay at Munnar Hotel.

DAY 08: MUNNAR SIGHTSEEING

Morning after breakfast, sightseeing in Munnar, which includes Raja Malai, a top peak of Munnar where you may see Neel Thar (mountain goats), Tea Museum, Mattupetty, Eco-Point etc. You can also enjoy chocolate factory, zip line, in evening visit the garden to see the different kind of lights of one can enjoy **(optional & own cost)**. After completing tour, return back to hotel. **Overnight stay at Munnar Hotel.**

Munnar: Munnar is a town in the south-western state of Kerala, India. Munnar is situated around 1600 m above sea level, in the Western Ghats range of mountains and is a hill station. The name Munnar is believed to mean "three rivers", referring to the location at the confluence of the Madhurapuzha, Nallathanni and Kundaly rivers. Munnar town is situated on the Kannan Devan Hills village in Devikulam taluk and is the largest panchayat in the Idukki district in Kerala having an area measuring nearly 557 km².



DAY 09: MUNNAR TO THEKKADY (90 KMS. APPROX 02 HRS. 30 MIN HRS. DRIVE)

After breakfast checkout from hotel, and drive to **Thekkady** on the way enjoy the beautiful greenery of Kerala spice garden and terrace farms. Thekkady in Kerala State, India's largest wildlife sanctuary is a dream destination for any tourist visiting India. The 120 years old 'Surki'

reserve, Thekkady, with its bountiful treasures

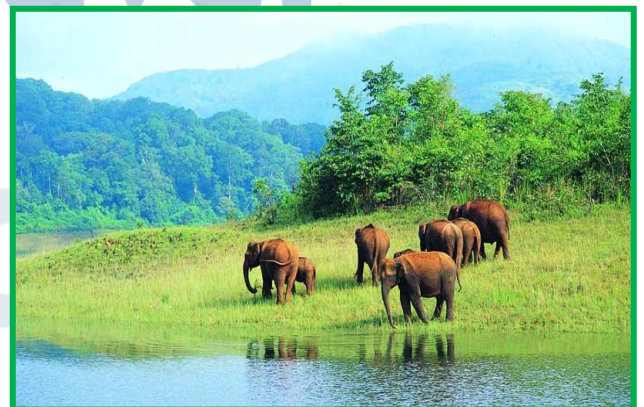

Overnight stay at Thekkady hotel.**

DAY 10: THEKKADY SIGHTSEEING

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DAY 11: THEKKADY TO ALLEPPEY (140 KMS. 03 HRS. APPROX.)

Morning after breakfast, check out and drive to Alleppey so called the Venice of East. On arrival at Alleppey after 1200noon you get onto a private House boat that is waiting to take you on a tour through the backwaters of Alleppey, a splendid area full of canals, lakes and coves. Very interestingly you get to see the whole life of people in here takes place here on the water. The people sail, fish, swim and bathe here. They do their washing. They are so adapted to the water that, you can see people talking for an hour, while they are up to their necks in water. (**Overnight on-board Houseboat**)


DAY 12: ALLEPPEY TO KUMARAKOM (APPROX 01 HRS DRIVE)

Morning after breakfast, check out from Houseboat. Drive to Kumarakom. Check in at hotel. Rest of the day free to enjoy the lake. Day free for massage and spa etc.

Overnight stay at Kumarakom hotel.

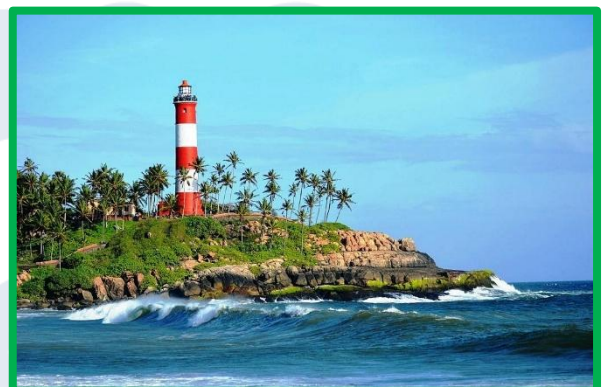

DAY 13: KUMARAKOM TO KOVALOM (180 KMS. 04 HRS. APPROX.)

Morning after breakfast, check out and drive to Kovalam, check in at hotel. Rest of the day free.

Overnight stay at Kovalam hotel.

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DAY 16: MADURAI SIGHTSEEING

Morning after breakfast, do Madurai visit the **Meenakshi temple** - one of the biggest temple complexes in India. The temple was constructed by **Kulasekara Pandya**. Later visit **palace of Tirumala Nayak** - It was built by King Thirumalai Nayak in year 1636 (hence its name) in Indo-saracenic style with tall arches gracing the palace. Being erstwhile residence to the king, only one-fourth of the actual structure is intact. **Gandhi Memorial Museum** - This museum is one of the five Gandhi Sangrahalayas (museums) in India. It was established in 1959 and houses an elaborate collection of illustrations - illustrations to show Indian freedom struggle and pictorial gallery depicting life of Mahatma Gandhi. After sightseeing return back to hotel. **Overnight stay at Madurai hotel.**



DAY 17: MADURAI TO TRICHY (126 KMS. 02 HRS. APPROX.)

After breakfast, Check out from the hotel and drive to Trichy. On arrival and check into the hotel. After freshen up visit **Sri Ranganathaswamy Temple** - most important pilgrim center in the district. Return to hotel. Evening free to Explore Trichy. **Overnight at Trichy hotel.**

DAY 18: TRICHY TO PONDICHERRY (200 KMS. 03 HRS. APPROX.)

After breakfast check out from hotel and depart for Pondicherry. On Arrival Check into the Hotel, Evening free at leisure or at personal activities. **Overnight at Pondicherry hotel.**

DAY 19: PONDICHERRY SIGHTSEEING

After Breakfast, do Sightseeing of Pondicherry.

Often referred to as the 'French Capital of India', Pondicherry is a vibrant city located on the south-eastern coast of India. Brimming with unspoiled beaches, heritage buildings, French and Tamil quarters, ancient temples and churches and a colonial ambience, this French Colony has a plethora of things to do and see.

Must-visits include the Temple, which features a colorful exterior and ornate sculptures; the Manakula Vinayagar Temple, known for its elephant blessings, huge golden chariot and ornately carved stone walls.



Established in 1926 by Sri Aurobindo (a renowned spiritual guru) and a French woman, called 'the mother', **Sri Aurobindo Ashram** is a must-visit for those seeking a spiritual retreat. Retreats here involve different meditation sessions and yoga practices that will transcend you into a state of peace. Later return to hotel. **Overnight stay at hotel.**

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DAY 20: PONDICHERRY TO CHENNAI VIA MAHABALIPURAM (166 KMS. 03 HRS. APPROX.)

Morning after breakfast meet our driver and drive to Chennai **Enroute** visit **Mahabalipuram**

Malappuram, or **Mahabalipuram**, is a town on a strip of land between the Bay of Bengal and the Great Salt Lake, in the south Indian state of Tamil Nadu. It's known for its temples and monuments built by the Pallava dynasty in the 7th and 8th centuries. The seafront Shore Temple comprises 3 ornate granite shrines. Krishna's Butter Ball is a massive boulder balanced on a small hill near the Ganesha Ratha stone temple. Check into hotel. **Overnight stay at Chennai Hotel.**


DAY 21: CHENNAI SIGHTSEEING

After breakfast at hotel. **Meet our driver** and proceed for sightseeing of **Chennai**.

Fort St. George, Govt. Museum, Valluvar Kottam, Kapleswarwar Temple, Santhome Cathedral. Drive along the **Marina Beach** - the most famous beach in Chennai.

Marina Beach is the second longest urban beach in India. Elliot's Beach- It is simply called Besant Nagar Beach, marks the end point of the Marina. The beach boasts scenic beauty with golden sand and clear waters, perfect for a refreshing dip or a leisurely walk along the shore. Drive pass visit of The High Court, Thousands Lights Mosque, the Secretariat & the Victory War Memorial. Later visit **Kapleswarwar Temple and Parthasarathy temple.**



Overnight stay at Chennai hotel.

DAY 22: CHENNAI TO TIRUPATI BY SURFACE (133 KMS. 03 HRS. APPROX.)

After breakfast, meet the Driver & drive to Tirupati. On Arrival Check into the Hotel, after fresh up do visit Lord Venkateshwara Temple & other Temples. After Sightseeing, Return Back to hotel.

Overnight Stay at Tirupathi Hotel.

Tirupati is the most frequented pilgrimage destinations in the country. It is dedicated to. Boasting a great spiritual importance among the Hindu devotees, Tirupati Balaji is one of the holiest and most frequented religious spots in India. Present as an abode of Lord Venkateshwara, an incarnation of Lord Vishnu, this temple is popular as 'Vaikuntam' on the earth. A horde of spiritual traveler's swarms this place every year to drench themselves in utter spirituality and serenity. Thousands of devotees visit this temple every day to pay homage to the utmost power.

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DAY 23: TIRUPATI TO PUTTAPARTHI BY SURFACE (223 KMS. 04 HRS. APPROX.)

After breakfast at the hotel, you will be drive to Puttaparthi. Upon arrival check-in at the hotel. **Overnight at Puttaparthi hotel.**

Puttaparthi is a town in Anantapur district of the Indian state of Andhra Pradesh. Puttaparthi is primarily famous as the birthplace and spiritual center of the Indian guru, Sathya Sai Baba. It's also known for the Prasanthi Nilayam, the ashram and headquarters of Sathya Sai Baba's organization, attracting devotees from around the world.

DAY 24: PUTTAPARTHI TO BANGALORE (156 KMS. 03 HRS. APPROX.)

After breakfast visit the temple and later drive to Bangalore. Upon arrival check-in at the hotel. Rest of the day free. **Overnight stay at Bangalore Hotel.**

Bengaluru (also called Bangalore) is the capital of India's southern Karnataka state. The center of India's high-tech industry, the city is also known for its parks and nightlife. By Cubbon Park, Vidhana Sabha is a Neo-Dravidian legislative building. Former royal residences include 19th-century Bangalore Palace, modeled after England's Windsor Castle, and Tipu Sultan's Summer Palace, an 18th-century teak structure.

DAY 25: BANGALORE SIGHTSEEING

After breakfast, proceed for full day sightseeing visit **Tipu Summer palace** – which the endearingly called rashk-e-Jannat (**the envy of heaven**). An inscription on the wooden screen describes the palace as the “abode of happiness”, almost mocking the ruins that surround it. Drive around **Vidhana Soudha** – this massive building houses the state legislature and the secretariat, **Cubbon Park** – this beautiful park, which spreads over 300 acres in the heart of the city, serves as the lung space of the ever-growing Bangalore city. Also Visit, **Lal Bagh or Lal Bagh Botanical Gardens**, meaning The Red Garden in English, is a well-known botanical garden in southern Bangalore, India. The garden was originally commissioned by Hyder Ali, the ruler of Mysore, and later finished by his son Tipu Sultan. It has a famous glass house which hosts an annual flower show. Lal Bagh houses India's largest collection of tropical plants, has an aquarium and a lake, and is one of the main tourist attractions in Bangalore. After completing tour return back to hotel. **Overnight Stay at Bangalore hotel.**


DAY 26: BANGALORE DEPARTURE

After breakfast, check out from the hotel. (**Check out time at hotel is 1200 Hrs**). Put the luggage in luggage room. Free for the day or for shopping (**at own/ no Vehicle**).

In time transfer to Bangalore airport to board the flight for onward destination.
