DAY 01 MEET UPON ARRIVAL AND TRANSFER TO HOTEL

On Arrival at Kathmandu airport by **Flight**. After clearing customs and immigration, come out exit gate and meet our assistance and transfer to hotel. (**Check in time at hotel is 1400 Hrs**) Check into the hotel. Rest for the day.

Overnight at Kathmandu Hotel.
DAY 02 AM: TOUR OF PASHUPATINATH & BOUDHANATH STUPA.
PM: TOUR OF PATAN CITY AND SWOYAMBHUNATH

After breakfast drive to City temple tour.

Pashupatinath temple: One of the most sacred Hindu shrines in the world, Pashupatinath lies 5 Km east of the city center. The richly-ornamented pagoda houses the sacred linga, or phallic symbol, of Lord Shiva. Chronicle indicates the temple's existence prior to 400 AD. Devotees can be seen taking ritual dips in the holy Bagmati River flowing beside the temple, also a World heritage site.

Boudnath Stupa Lies about 6 km to the east of downtown Kathmandu and is the largest stupa in the valley. It looms 36 meters high and present one of the most fascinating specimens of stupa design. Bhoonath a world heritage is also known as Khasti. There are more than 45 Buddhist monasteries in the area

Swoyambhunath Stupa: Watches over the valley from the top of a hillock on its western side, the stupa is one of the holiest Buddhist sites in Nepal and its establishment is linked to the creation of the Kathmandu Valley out of a primordial lake. Swayambhu is also known as Sengu and is listed as a World heritage site.

Patan City: Like its counterpart in Kathmandu, is an enchanting mélange of palace buildings, artistic courtyard and former Royal palace complex is the center of Patan's religious and social life, and houses a museum containing an array of bronze statues and religious objects. One remarkable monument here is a 16 th century temple dedicated to the Hindu goes Krishna, built entirely of stone.

Later drive back to the hotel. **Overnight stay at Kathmandu hotel.**


DAY 03 AFTER BREAKFAST DRIVE TO POKHARA & EVENING BOATING AT PHEWA LAKE

After breakfast drive to Pokhara which will take about 6 hours' drive and is about 200 Km. Pokhara is a place of remarkable natural beauty. The serenity of Phewa Lake and the magnificence of the fish tail summit rising behind it create an ambiance of peace and magic. At an elevation lower than Kathmandu, it has much more tropical feel to it, a fact well appreciated by the beautiful diversity of flowers which prosper in its environ. Indeed, the valley surrounding Pokhara is home to thick forest, gushing rivers, emerald lakes and of course, the world famous. Views of the Himalayas. On arrival and check into the hotel. Rest for the day.

Overnight stay at Pokhara hotel.


DAY 04 MORNING VISIT SHIVA STAU AT PUMDIKOT. VISIT DEVI'S FALL, GUPTESWOR & BINDABASINI.

After breakfast, drive to Pokhara and proceed for Pokhara city tour.

SHIVA STATUE, PUMDIKOT Pumdikot view tower in Pokhara is one of the most incredible vantage points situated in Nepal. Known for its 3-tiered Shiva Statue and the picturesque views of Annapurna Himalayan Range, Machhapuchre, Dhaulagiri, Manaslu and many other neighbouring mountains The Pumdikot is an emerging destination around Pokhara that features a shiva statue, natural settlement, lake view, valley view, mountains and peaceful scenery. The Shiva idol in the Phumdihumdi village is about 108 ft tall, but the actual Shiva's sitting statue is 51 ft tall.

DEVI'S FALL On 31st July 1961 A.D. in the afternoon a sudden flood from Fewa Lake swept away a Swiss citizen Mrs. Devis who was having a bath with her husband beside it. She was flowed and dead. She was recovered after a long attempt since then. It has been taken its name "Devi's fall" Length: 500 meters underground water flow. Depth: 100 Feet. Most people pronounce Devi's fall as Davi's Fall. Locally known as **Patale Chhango**.

GUPTESWOR Gupteswor is a famous cave in Pokhara. Inside the cave we can find the temple of the Lord Shiva. Lord Shiva is great god of Hindu. People worship to Lord Shiva and pray for their happiness and wealth. You can also see the beautiful temple in this cave. Gupteshwor Mahadev Cave a huge stalagmite worshiped as a **Shiva lingam**. The ticket only covers the temple, there you can pay another a low tunnel behind the cave, the behind a spring water of Devi, Falls. At the ceiling of the cave, you can see cracks and beautiful mark by the force of the waters. There are two caves inside it. You have to pay entry fee to see the natural cave of Gupteswor,



electricity is managed for convenience of visitors. Second part of the cave closes during the Jun, July, Aug and September due to heavy rain and flood from Devi's fall. It is an interesting experience to visit Gupteswor.

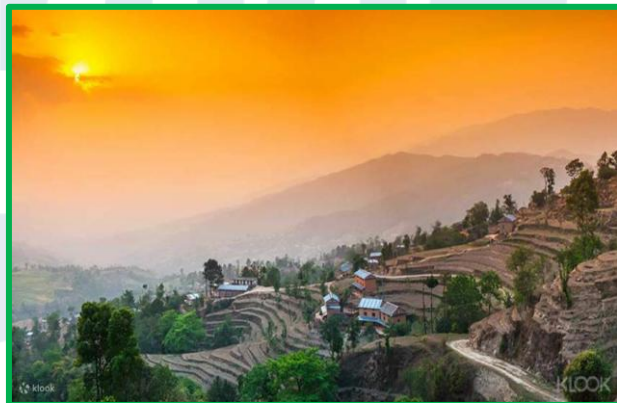
BINDABASINI TEMPLE: Situated in the northern part of the beautiful lake city of Nepal is the temple of Bindabasini. Located near the busy Old Bazaar of Pokhara, the temple of Bindabasini stands proudly at about 3000 feet above the sea level along the Annapurna and Machhapuhhare Himalayan Range. Bindabasini temple, the temple of the guardian deity is of great religious value to the Hindus living in Pokhara. The temple is dedicated to the Hindu goddess Durga and is regarded as the guardian deity of Pokhara.

Later drive back to the hotel. **Overnight stay at Pokhara hotel.**

DAY 05 AFTER BREAKFAST DRIVE DIRECTLY TO NAGARKOT

After breakfast, check out from the hotel and drive to **Nagarkot**. On arrival and check into the hotel. After freshen up proceed for local Nagarkot sightseeing.

Nagarkot. Of the possible destination, Nagarkot (altitude 2175m) is by far the most popular. Located 30Km east of Kathmandu, Nagarkot has developed into favourite weekend getaway among these seeking mountain views in comfort and quiet. At sunrise, the Himalayan range, stretching from Dhaulagiri in the west all the way past Everest to Kanchenjunga in the east, emerges from the darkness to greet the happy visitor with its awe-inspiring majesty and beauty. A gentle drive to the east of



Kathmandu, Nagarkot is a hill resort. Passes through terraced fields and strutted houses, you can view the spectacular mountain ranges such as Annapurna I, II, III, Dorjee Lakpa, Guari Shanker, Shisabangma and Ganesh Himal. You also can see Mount Everest only in a clear day. Later drive back to the hotel. **Overnight stay at Nagarkot hotel.**

DAY 06 MORNING VIEW SUNRISE / DRIVE BACK TO KATHMANDU
ENROUTE TOUR OF SANGA AND DOLESHWOR MAHADEV.
AFTERNOON VISIT KATHMANDU DURBAR SQUARE. EVENING FREE TIME FOR SHOPPING AROUND THAMEL

After breakfast, check out from the hotel and drive to **Kathmandu**. Enroute visit **SANGA AND DOLESHWOR MAHADEV**. On arrival and check into the hotel. After freshen up proceed for local Kathmandu sightseeing.

SANGA - TALLEST SHIVA STATUE: The statue of Shiva located at Sanga is 108ft. tall making it the tallest statue of Shiva in the world and lies on the way to Dhulikhel from Kathmandu. Shiva's vehicle lies in the front of Statue and statues of Parvati, Ganesh and Kumar is at the left corner. It extends in 75 ropanies of land and is engrossed with well-maintained garden and a series of 12 shiva lingams.

Kedarnath The Doleshwor Mahadev temple that is considered religiously important is located at Sipadol-6, 4 km south of Jagati, Bhaktapur. This temple is worshipped as the head of the Lord Kedarnath. According to the long-held belief, the head of the deity originated in this place while the remaining body part in Kedarnath of India. A large rock outcropping amidst green forest is worshipped as a representation of Lord Kedarnath

Kathmandu City Durbar Square: Complex of palaces, courtyards and temples, built between the 12th and 18th centuries, used to be the seat of the ancient Malla kings of Kathmandu. An intriguing piece here is the 17th century stone inscription set into the wall of the palace with writings in 15 languages. The Durbar Square, protected as a UNESCO world heritage site, is the social, religious and urban focal point of the city. There are also museums inside the palace building. There is also a temple of the only

LIVING GODDESS – KUMARI.

THAMEL: As the tourist district of Kathmandu, Thamel bustles with activity late into the night. It is a mere 10-minute walk from the centre of Kathmandu, yet completely different from the rest of the city. Thamel caters entirely to tourists with its scores of hotels, rows of restaurants and bars, book shops, inviting souvenir shops, cyber cafes and travel agencies. All that a tourist needs can be found here, even friends and traveling companions.

Evening free for shopping. Later back to the hotel. **Overnight stay at Kathmandu hotel.**
